

CHAPTER 83

AN ACT

[S. B. 70]

To amend paragraph 2 of Subsection (A) of Section 13 of Chapter 78 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, as amended by Chapter 70 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, relating to intoxicating liquors, and providing additional penalties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That paragraph 2 of Subsection (A) of Section 13 of Chapter 78 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, as amended by Chapter 70 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, be amended by adding at the end of the said paragraph the following matter:

Graduated
penalties for
liquor violations.

Penalty for violation of any of the provisions of this Act shall be as follows:

For the first violation, the licensed premises shall be closed for a period of forty-five (45) days;

For the second violation, the licensed premises shall be closed for a period of ninety (90) days;

For the third violation, the bond shall be forfeited, the license cancelled and the premises abated for one year for use as a beverage dispensary.
