

CHAPTER 84

AN ACT

[S. C. S. H. B. 19]

To amend Section 4065, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended by Chapter 58, Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, relating to costs and disbursements in civil actions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 4065, Compiled Laws of Alaska, as amended by Chapter 58, Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, is amended by substituting a semi-colon for the period after the last word of said section, and adding thereto the following: "and a reasonable attorneys' fee to be fixed by the court".

CHAPTER 85

AN ACT

[H. B. 102]

To amend Sections 3151 and 3159, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to the Motor Vehicle Tax.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 3151, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 3151. AMOUNT OF TAX; HALF YEAR TAX. Any person firm or corporation who shall run or operate any motor vehicle in the Territory of Alaska shall apply for, obtain and pay for a license in the manner and amounts hereinafter set forth.

(a) On automobiles, buses or trucks carrying passengers for hire, including U-drive cars, twenty dollars, \$20.00 per annum.

For hire

(b) On all other automobiles, delivery cars, motorcycles, and tractors where customarily used on the streets or public highways, ten dollars per annum. All trucks engaged in hauling or transporting freight, twenty-five dollars, \$25.00 per annum.

(c) For vehicle dealers, fifteen dollars for first set of demonstration license plates and seven dollars fifty cents for each additional set, such dealer plates to be used only in demonstrating vehicles for sale; provided, that such plates shall not be used on any one vehicle for more than ten consecutive days.

“per annum” shall be deemed to mean for the calendar year for which issued.

After September first the license fees shall be one half of the above amounts for the balance of the calendar year.

Section 2. That Section 3159, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is amended by adding the following at the end of said section:

“Further provided, that the foregoing exemption shall not apply if the aforesaid owner or operator becomes gainfully employed.”
