

CHAPTER 86

AN ACT

[H. B. 93]

To amend Section 3138(h), Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended, relating to taxes on fish traps; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 3138(h), Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended by Section 3 of Chapter 10, Session Laws of Alaska, 1946 Ex., is amended to read as follows:

License fees:

Hand traps.
Pile and

floating traps.

(h) Fish traps: hand driven or stake traps located on tide lands, Seventy-five Dollars per annum. Pile driven or floating traps, Three Hundred Dollars per annum, so called dummy traps included; and an additional tax of Four Dollars per one thousand fish caught in any one trap in excess of one hundred thousand. In addition to the above tax, any person, firm or corporation occupying and operating more than three traps shall pay an additional \$150.00 per trap for the fourth to tenth trap inclusive, and an additional three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per trap for the tenth to the twentieth and an additional four hundred dollars (\$400.00) per trap for the twenty first to fiftieth and an additional five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for all traps over fifty.

Emergency

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
