CHAPTER 89

AN ACT

[C. S. H. B. 113]

To appropriate the sum of \$8,476,309.94 or as much thereof as shall be found necessary for the expenses of the Territory of Alaska for the Biennium beginning April 1, 1947 and ending March 31, 1949, and for the school biennium beginning July 1, 1947 and ending June 30, 1949, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of \$8,476,309.94 or so much thereof as shall be found necessary is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the expenses of the Territory for the biennium commencing April 1, 1947 and ending March 31, 1949, and for the school biennium commencing July 1, 1947 and ending June 30, 1949, said sum to be apportioned according to the following schedules:
