BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the sum of \$26,000.00 or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the payment of printing and binding of the Senate and House Journals, Session Laws and advance sheets; and for printing and furnishing stationery and other printing for the use of the Legislature.

7. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the sum of \$18,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of per diem in lieu of subsistence at the rate of \$7.00 per day for the members of the Legislature, for each day of attendance at a Legislative Session together with travel time incident thereto.

The monies hereby appropriated shall be paid by warrants drawn on the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon vouchers approved by the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives.

8. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the sum of \$3700.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the moneys in the Treasury of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the payment of work involved in compiling the Journals of the Senate and the House of Representatives subsequent to the present session and for extra compensation to the employees of the Legislature, said sum to be appropriated according to the following schedules:
