TO THE HIGHWAY ENGINEER AND THE TERRITORIAL BOARD
OF ROAD COMMISSIONERS:

Your memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska, in Eighteenth Session assembled, respectfully represents that:

WHEREAS, there is need for the construction of a Territorial highway near and without the city limits of Ketchikan, Alaska;

NOW, THEREFORE, your memorialist respectfully prays that the sum of \$100,000.00, or so much thereof as may be needed, be allocated for the construction of such highway, and that appropriate action be taken by the Highway Engineer and the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for the construction of such highway and maintenance thereof.

TO THE COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION AND THE TERRI-

NOW, THEREFORE, your memorialist respectfully prays that appropriate action be taken by the Commissioner of Education and the Territorial Board of Education to have such school constructed.
