

HOUSE MEMORIAL NO. 4

TO THE HONORABLE ERNEST GRUENING, GOVERNOR OF ALASKA:

Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Eighteenth Session of the Territorial Legislature, respectfully submits that:

WHEREAS, A. H. Ziegler, of Ketchikan, Alaska, has been a member of the Territorial Board of Education continuously since the date of the creation of the Board in 1933 and until the present time, but his term of office expires on March 31, 1947; and he has held the office of President of the Board for the past two years; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ziegler has been a faithful attendant at every meeting of every session of the Board since the date of his appointment until the present session from which he was obliged to be absent on account of illness, and at all times during his fourteen years of office he has performed his duties as a member not only at meetings of the Board, but during the intervals between meetings faithfully, efficiently and ably, and in the best interests of the Territory and its educational system, and with entire satisfaction to the general public; and

WHEREAS, the entire membership of the Board of Education of Alaska, by resolution passed by the Board March 1, 1947, expressed its deep appreciation for the services rendered by Mr. Ziegler and especially his wise counsel and willingness at all times to cooperate with the other members of the Board and with the Commissioner of Education; and

WHEREAS, you have seen fit not to reappoint Mr. Ziegler to the Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, it would be to the best interest of the Territory of Alaska in general, and to the Board of Education in particular, that you reconsider your action and reappoint Mr. Ziegler as a member of the Board of Education.

NOW, THEREFORE, your Memorialist prays that you appoint Mr. A. H. Ziegler of Ketchikan, Alaska, as a member of the Terri-

torial Board of Education for a term beginning April 1, 1947, in order that the best interest of the Board of Education and of the Territory of Alaska may thereby be fostered and promoted.
