

## Senate Joint Resolutions

### SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, Axel Werner, a miner and pioneer resident of the Territory of Alaska, is a permanent invalid confined to bed, with an incurable ailment, and requires constant hospitalization and medical care, and

WHEREAS, the nature of his ailment does not permit his admittance to the Pioneers' Home at Sitka, and

WHEREAS, Axel Werner, as a permanent pioneer resident of this Territory for the past thirty-five years, contributed much toward the development and progress of Alaska through prospecting and mining over a period of thirty-three years, and

WHEREAS, he is without any means whatsoever, nor without resources to provide for such services, and is not eligible to receive sufficient funds from any other source for such care,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Public Welfare of the Territory of Alaska is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the Maynard Columbus Hospital at Nome, Alaska an amount not exceeding Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per day for the permanent hospitalization and medical care of Axel Werner out of the funds appropriated for allowance to aged residents of the Territory of Alaska.
