

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, Minnie Fields operates a private dependent childrens' home near Juneau, Alaska; and,

WHEREAS, Minnie Fields was injured by falling several years ago, thereby injuring the nerve of the right arm, since which time said arm has been paralyzed; and,

WHEREAS, she was awarded a Federal allowance from the U. S. Compensation Commission, which she received for several months; and,

WHEREAS, during this time she was ordered to Seattle for physical examination by the U. S. Public Health Department for the U. S. Employees Compensation; and,

WHEREAS, a year later when she was asked again to return to Seattle for physical examination she was unable to go on account of having under her care too many children; and, her allowance was withdrawn and she now works without remuneration caring for destitute children in the home she has established;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA: That the Department of Public Welfare is hereby authorized and directed to pay the sum of \$60.00 per month from its appropriation, to said Minnie Fields as long as she conducts a private dependent children's home, or until such time as the Board of Public Welfare determines such payments are necessary.
