HOUSE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 3

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY
OF ALASKA IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

1. That the sum of \$210.00 is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of salaries to certain members of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska during the present session, said sum to be apportioned according to the following schedules:

Senator Don Carlos Brownell	\$ 15.00
Senator John Butrovich, Jr.	\$ 15.00
Senator Leo Rogge	\$ 180.00

2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the sum of \$1,500.00. or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of Alaska not otherwise appropriated to carry out the provisions of section one (1) of House Joint Resolution No. 1, 1947, (payment of salaries to persons employed by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska during the present session) because of an existing deficiency.

3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the sum of \$3700.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the moneys in the Treasury of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the payment of work involved in compiling the Journals of the Senate and the House of Representatives subsequent to the present session and for extra compensation to the employees of the Legislature, said sum to be appropriated according to the following schedules:

(a) For compensation to Andrew Nerland, President of the Senate for supervising and preparing the Senate Journal subsequent to the present session of the Legislature	\$200.00
(b) For compensation to Oscar S. Gill, Speaker of the House for supervising and preparing the House Journal subsequent to the present session of the Legislature	\$200.00
(c) For compensation to Jesta M. Mitchell, Secretary of the Senate, for work performed at the request of the Legislature subsequent to the present session	\$200.00
(d) For compensation to William L. Paul Sr., Chief Clerk of the House for work performed at the request of the Legislature subsequent to the present session	\$200.00
(e) For compensation to Marguerite Seaton, Assistant Secretary of the Senate for work performed at the request of the Legislature subsequent to the present session	\$200.00
(f) For compensation to Bonnie Jo Gronroos, Assistant Clerk of the House of Representatives, for work performed at the request of the Legislature subsequent to the present session	\$200.00
(g) For compensation to employees of the Legislature, other than the Secretary and Assistant Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk and Assistant Clerk of the House; to be allotted equally among all said employees	\$2,500.00

4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT each member of the Eighteenth Territorial Legislature be permitted to take with him or her the volume of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, used by him or her during the present session.
