ending of continuous travel, constituting a travel period, one fourth of a calendar day will be allowed for each six hours or fraction thereof. For continuous travel of less than twenty-four hours, however, constituting a travel period, such period will be regarded as commencing with the beginning of the travel and ending with the completion thereof and for each six-hour period or fraction thereof, one-fourth of the rate for a calendar day will be allowed, provided that no per diem will be allowed when the departure is after 8 A.M. and the return on the same day is prior to 6 P.M.; or for any absence not exceeding three hours.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

 CHAPTER 34

## AN ACT

[S. B. 25]

To amend Section 37-2-5 ACLA 1949 pertaining to the place of meeting of the Territorial Board of Education; and establishing an effective date.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 37-2-5 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 37-2-5. MEETINGS OF BOARD AND NOTICE THEREOF: QUORUM: VOTING.

Regular meetings of the Board of Education shall be held at the capital during regular sessions of the Territorial Legislature. All other regular meetings shall be held at such time and place in the Territory as may be designated by the Board; provided, that special meetings shall be called by the Commissioner of Education at the written request of a majority of the members of the Board, or may be called by the Governor on his own initiative, at such places in the Territory as may be designated in the call for the special meeting. Written or telegraphic notice of all regular and special meetings of the Board of Education shall be given to each member thereof at his last known address at least fifteen (15) days prior to the date of such meeting. The regular meetings of the Board shall not last to exceed ten (10) days, and a special meeting shall last not to exceed five (5) days. Three (3) members shall constitute a quorum but a less number may adjourn from day to day for a period not exceeding ten (10) days; provided, however, that no action may be taken or resolution or motion adopted by the Board unless at least three (3) affirmative votes are in favor thereof.
