

CHAPTER 92

AN ACT

[H. B. 40]

To encourage the discovery and development of commercial uranium deposits in the Territory of Alaska; making an appropriation; and providing an effective date.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Purpose.

Section 1. It is the purpose of this Act to stimulate and encourage the prospecting for, and the production of uranium from deposits within the Territory of Alaska.

Minimum requirement.

Section 2. Any person shall be entitled to and shall receive from the Territory of Alaska a bonus in the amount of ten thousand dollars for the discovery and production of the first twenty short tons (two thousand pounds avoirdupois dry weight per ton) of uranium bearing ores or mechanical concentrates assaying twenty per cent or more U^{308} by weight from any single mining location, lode or placer, in the Territory of Alaska, which has not previously been worked for uranium; provided, however, that the United States Atomic Energy Commission shall have first accepted such ores or concentrates and shall have paid such person a bonus of ten thousand dollars pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1946 and the rules, regulations, and orders of the United States Atomic Energy Commission.

Additional requirement.

Commissioner of mines to certify.

Section 3. Upon being satisfied that the conditions and terms of the preceding section have been complied with by the person applying for the bonus provided for by this Act, the Commissioner of Mines for the Territory shall duly certify a voucher in the amount of ten thousand dollars, payable to such person, which voucher shall be approved by the Auditor and paid from the Territorial Treasury upon a warrant issued by the Treasurer.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated, out of moneys in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, ^{Appropriation.} the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars to carry out the provisions of this Act.

Section 5. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 93

AN ACT

[H. B. 75]

To provide for the licensing of sport fishing in the Territory of Alaska; to require license fees; to define violations and to prescribe penalties; to provide for exemptions; to provide for an effective date.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. DEFINITIONS. For the purpose of this ^{Definitions.} Act:

(a) "Sports Fishing" shall be construed to mean taking or fishing for any fresh water, marine or anadromous ^{Sports fishing.} fish by angling or by other legal means and legal gear for personal use, and not for sale or barter.

(b) "Resident" shall be construed to mean a person ^{Resident.} who has resided in the Territory for 12 months immediately preceding application for such license and after having established residence, retains it by continued residence in the Territory or preserves it by not establishing residence elsewhere.
