

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, copies of the Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated 1949 and other books furnished to each member of the Twentieth Session of the Alaska Legislature for the use of the members in consideration of legislation before them; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the said members to take the said Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated and other books to their respective homes at the end of the session;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that each member of the Twentieth Session of the Alaska Legislature, Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and Secretary of the Senate be permitted to take the Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated and other books used by him during the present session, with him or her.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 3

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

1. That the sum of \$2,500.00, or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, as payment to the Council of State Governments for services rendered by Mr. H. Clyde Reeves, and his necessary expenses, for the Twentieth Session of the Alaska Legislature in the matter of planning reorganization of the Territorial Government.

2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies hereby appropriated shall be paid by warrant drawn on the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska upon a voucher approved by the Treasurer of Alaska and the Auditor of Alaska.

3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
