(3) No agreement under the terms of subsection (m) herein shall be valid without the prior authorization of a majority vote of the four commissioners.

(4) All moneys received from the United States for the payments authorized herein for such lands and buildings shall be deposited in the Unemployment Compensation Administration Fund in the Territorial Treasury and are hereby appropriated therefrom for purposes of this Act.

(5) It is declared to be the policy of this Territory that in the event such premises are purchased pursuant to this Act, the Employment Security Commission, or such other department of the Territory as may hereafter perform its functions, shall be housed therein without further payment therefor by the United States, except for general maintenance, utilities and janitorial services; or if, in the future, it may be desirable to move said Employment Security Commission, other suitable similar space will be furnished by the Territory to said Commission without further payment therefor by the United States, except for general maintenance, utilities and janitorial services.

## CHAPTER 114

### AN ACT

[S. B. 98]

To amend Section 35-4-21 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1949,

by adding a new section thereto, providing for the issuance of a Retail Stock Sale License.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 35-4-21 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1949, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: After Section K, add new Section L.

L. Retail Stock Sale License. A Retail Stock Sale License shall give to the holder thereof the right to sell in bulk quantities, of not less than five wine gallons per sale, but not to the consumer, the entire stock of a former retail liquor store, where the owner thereof is desirous of closing out or terminating the business of the store. Such license shall issue only when the owner does not have a retail license, but not where he has been deprived of a retail license because of a violation of this Act, or a violation of any other law of the Territory of Alaska. Such license shall issue for a period of ninety days only for each store so closing out, and shall not be renewable. A Retail Stock Sale License Fee shall be one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

### AN ACT

[C. S. S. Bs. Nos. 78 and 112]

Controlling plats, subdivisions and dedications and creating Boards of Platting and defining their jurisdiction; providing for the alteration and vacation of plats and further providing for standards to govern the recording of plats and prescribing penalties for the violation of this Act, and repealing Sections 16-6-1 and 16-6-2 ACLA 1949; and making an appropriation.
