

CHAPTER 14

AN ACT

[H. B. 31]

To amend section 26-1-1 ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 20, SLA 1949, pertaining to liens.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 26-1-1 ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 20, SLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Persons entitled
to file lien.

Section 26-1-1. CERTAIN PERSONS ENTITLED TO LIEN FOR WORK OR LABOR DONE OR MATERIALS FURNISHED. Any person or firm, contractor, lumber merchant, architect, engineer, designer, mechanic, artisan, machinist, tradesman, plumber, electrician, carpenter, painter, laborer, teamster, drayman, and other persons performing design or supervision services or performing any labor upon or preliminary to the construction of, or furnishing any material for the construction, alteration, or repair, either in whole or in part of any building, wharf, bridge, flume, fence, machinery or aqueduct, or any structure or superstructure, including the clearing, grading, draining, excavating or landscaping of the ground upon which such building, wharf, bridge, flume, fence, machinery or aqueduct, or any structure or superstructure may be constructed, and the installation of sewer and water lines therein, shall have a lien upon the same for the work or labor done or material furnished at the instance of the owner of the building or other improvement, or his agent.

CHAPTER 15

AN ACT

[H. B. 18]

To amend Section 14-4-1 (d) ACLA 1949, relating to Purchases on

Bids, Calls for Bids, Award of Contracts, Applicability of Provisions to Common Carriers, Emergency Purchases, Purchase of Food, Clothing and Medical Supplies Excepted.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 14-4-1 (d) ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 14-4-1 (d) The provisions of this Act shall include all forms of common carriers and particularly boats, airplanes, and buses, but shall not extend to payments made to common carriers operating scheduled trips at regular tariffs offered the general public; provided, however, that the provisions of this Act applicable to bus contracts for the transportation of pupils to and from public schools in the Territory, be suspended.

Coverage.

School bus transportation contracts excepted.

CHAPTER 16

AN ACT

[S. B. 2]

To amend the Eighth subsection of Section 36-4-2 ACLA 1949, relating to non-profit corporations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the Eighth subsection of Section 36-4-2 ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Vote required for amendment of articles.

Eighth. Said articles of incorporation may be amended at any regular meeting of the members or shareholders of the corporation or at any special meeting of the same called for that purpose, by a vote of two-thirds of the members or shareholders present or represented at the meeting. No amendment of the articles of incorporation shall be made at any regular meeting, and
