CHAPTER 54

AN ACT

[H. B. 169]

Relating to limit of amount of expenditure for rescue or relief,  
 amending Section 40-8-6, Chapter 8, ACLA 1949.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Section 40-8-6, Chapter 8, ACLA 1949 is  
 hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 40-8-6. LIMITATION OF AMOUNT  
 OF EXPENDITURE FOR RESCUE OR RE-  
 LIEF. No United States Commissioner or Post-  
 master shall obligate or bind the Territory in a  
 greater sum than Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00)  
 Dollars in any one case of rescue or relief, unless  
 the affirmative approval of the Governor shall  
 first have been obtained; when the Governor  
 gives such approval he shall state therein the

additional amount that may be expended, if necessary, in each case, and such approval shall be attached to the vouchers of the Commissioner or Postmaster, as the case may be.

## CHAPTER 55

### AN ACT

[S. B. 18]

To amend Sec. 37-2-5, ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 34, SLA 1951, relating to meetings of the Board of Education.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Sec. 37-2-5, ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 34, SLA 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### Sec. 37-2-5. MEETINGS OF BOARD AND NOTICE THEREOF: QUORUM: VOTING.

Regular meetings.

Regular meetings of the Board of Education shall be held at the capitol during regular sessions of the Territorial Legislature. All other regular meetings shall be held at such time and place in the Territory as may be designated by the Board; provided, that special meetings shall be called by the Commissioner of Education at the written request of a majority of the members of the Board, or may be called by the Governor on his own initiative, at such places in the Territory as may be designated in the call for the special meeting. Written or telegraphic notice of all regular and special meetings of the Board of Education shall be given to each member thereof at his last known address at least fifteen (15) days prior to the date of such meeting. The regular meetings of the Board shall last not to exceed fifteen (15) days, and a special
