

hereafter admitted to the Pioneers' Home, except persons admitted under Section 51-2-14 ACLA 1949, who receives income from any source whatsoever in excess of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars per month may be required, by the Board of Trustees to pay such excess to the Superintendent of said Home immediately upon receipt thereof in payment, or part payment, of the cost of his maintenance.

At the end of each month said Superintendent shall transmit all

such payments to the Territorial Treasurer together with the names of the persons making same and the amount paid by each. Provided, that the Board of Trustees is hereby authorized to pay the sum of \$5.00 per month to any resident without funds.

All moneys thus received shall be covered into the General Fund.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 159

### AN ACT

**Relating to the construction program for the University of Alaska; and making an appropriation.**

(H. B. 197)

**Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the University of Alaska the sum of \$1,300,000.00, or so much thereof as may be matched as hereinafter provided, out of any moneys in the General Fund not otherwise appropriated. The appropriation herein provided shall be

made available according to the following schedule: (a) \$650,000.00 to be made available on October 1, 1957; and (b) \$650,000.00 to be made available on October 1, 1958.

Section 2. The moneys appropriated shall be expended on construction of buildings and facilities on the campus of the University of Alaska; Provided however, that

only so much of the appropriation herein shall be expended as shall be equally matched from any Federal funds available for such construction.

Section 3. Upon proof satisfactory to the Territorial Treasurer that

equal funds are or will be available from Federal participation, the Treasurer shall transfer by warrant such amounts as are or will be so matched within the limits of the appropriation and schedule provided in Section 1 of this Act.

## CHAPTER 160

### AN ACT

**To require non-resident agents or brokers placing policies or contracts of insurance with an association or associations of individuals, or a member or members of such association, to report both premium and losses each year in the same manner as is required of domestic, foreign and alien insurance companies, and amending Section 42-3-2, ACLA 1949.**

(H. B. 212)

**Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. Section 42-3-2, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 42-3-2. **Licensing non-resident Agents and Brokers.** The Insurance Commissioner may issue licenses to non-resident agents and brokers authorizing them, during the time such agent or broker shall conform to the provisions hereof, to solicit, accept

applications for, write, issue, or place policies or contracts of insurance, or to effect insurance upon risks located within the Territory, other than life, with an association or associations of individuals, or a member or members of such association, whether organized within this Territory or elsewhere formed upon or under a plan whereby one or more Associate Underwriters of such association become liable for a proportion of the whole amount insured by a group of, or all of,
