

CHAPTER 85

AN ACT

Making the Superintendent of Territorial Police the Inspector of Weights and Measures; amending Sec. 35-5-2, ACLA, 1949, as amended by Sec. 1 of Ch. 94, SLA, 1951, amending Sec. 2 of Ch. 94, SLA, 1951.

(S. B. 47)

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1, Section 35-5-2, Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated, 1949, as amended by Section 1 of Chapter 94, Session Laws of Alaska, 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 35-5-2. Superintendent of Territorial Police, Ex-Officio Inspector of Weights and Measures.

The Superintendent of Territorial Police shall be ex-officio inspector of weights and measures and of weighing and measuring appliances. It shall be his duty to procure and keep such standard sets of weights and measures as may be found necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act; he shall test or cause to be tested, by such standards, all weights, measures, weighing and measuring appliances and devices used in the ascertainment of weight or measure in the buying, selling, or transporting of goods, wares, merchandise, or other commodi-

ties and to seal such as are found accurate with an appropriate seal or mark to be kept by him for that purpose; such seal or mark shall be placed so as to be easily seen, and shall show the date on which the inspection is made.

Section 2, Section 2 of Chapter 94, Session Laws of Alaska, 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2. From and after the effective date of this Act the Superintendent of Territorial Police shall do and perform all acts heretofore done and performed by the Tax Commissioner under the provisions of Section 35-5-2 to 35-5-11, inclusive, Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated, 1949, as amended by Chapter 94, Session Laws of Alaska, 1951.

Section 3. All records and property pertaining to weights and measures shall be transferred from the office of the Tax Commissioner to the Superintendent of Police.
