

## CHAPTER 23

## AN ACT

**Amending Title 43, Chapter 2 Article 2 ACLA 1949 by adding a new section 43-2-13 relating to payments to an employee Health, Welfare or Pension Fund.**

(H. B. 40)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. Title 43, Chapter 2, Article 2 ACLA 1949 is hereby thereunder designated as Section amended by adding a new section 43-2-13 to read as follows:

**43-2-13. Penalty for Intentional Failure to Make Required Payments into Health, Welfare and or Pension Fund.** Whenever any employer has agreed with any employee or group of employees to make payments to a health, welfare and/or pension fund or such

other fund for the benefit of the employees, or has entered into a collective bargaining agreement providing for such payments, it shall be unlawful for such employer to intentionally fail to make the payments required by the terms of any such agreement. Each violation of this Act shall constitute a separate offense and any person found guilty of the same shall be punished in accordance with the schedule of punishment for a misdemeanor set forth in Section 43-2-3 ACLA 1949.

## CHAPTER 24

## AN ACT

**Concerning gifts of securities to minors.**

(H. B. 42)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. Any adult person may make a gift of securities to a person who has not attained the age of 21 years on the date of the gift (hereinafter referred to as the "minor") in the following manner:

(a) Securities, if in registered form, shall be registered by the

donor in his own name or in the name of any adult member of the minor's family or in the name of any guardian of the minor, followed by the words "as custodian, for ....., a minor, under the laws of Alaska", and the securities shall be delivered to the person in whose name they are thus registered as custodian.
