AN ACT

Relating to aid to the blind; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 47.25.640 is amended to read:

Sec. 47.25.640. AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE. The department shall determine the amount of assistance granted for a needy blind person with due regard to the resources and needs of the person and the conditions existing in each case. Assistance shall be sufficient to provide the applicant with reasonable subsistence compatible with decency and health, and according to the standards of assistance established by the department. However, assistance shall not exceed \$200 a month. Direct payments for medical services and remedial care shall not be considered in determining the maximum amount payable.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
