AN ACT

Relating to state parole board membership.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 33.15.010 is amended to read:

Sec. 33.15.010. STATE BOARD OF PAROLE. There is in the department a board of parole consisting of five members to be appointed by the governor. One of the members, who shall be chairman of the board, shall be a person with training or experience in the field of probation and parole, and he may be an official or employee of the department but may not be an official or employee of the youth and adult authority. The term of each of the other four members of the board is four years and until his successor is appointed and qualifies. Successors are appointed in the same manner as provided for the board members first appointed. A vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term.
