JOINT RESOLUTION

Requesting a post office for Chuloonawick, Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Village of Chuloonawick has a population of approximately 130 people; and

WHEREAS the people of the village are quite actively engaged in fishing and in the fish processing operation which is carried on there; and

WHEREAS the village is presently not served by regular mail service, there being about 60 days between each pickup and delivery, and this results in undue hardship on the residents of Chuloonawick; and

WHEREAS Chuloonawick is located on an air route between Emmonak and Kotlik which is operated by Wien Airlines; and

WHEREAS year 'round landings can be made at the village by ski-equipped planes in the winter and by floatplanes in the summer;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Postmaster General is respectfully requested to establish a post office and postal services in Chuloonawick, Alaska.

COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Winton Blount, Postmaster General of the United States; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens, and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators and to the Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
