HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 16

A remembrance of Martin Luther King, Jr. on the first anniversary of his death.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS one year ago today an assassin's bullet took the life of Martin Luther King, Jr.; and

WHEREAS Martin Luther King, Jr. was a man dedicated to the proposition that all men are created equal and to the tenets of brotherhood and love; and

WHEREAS the senseless tragedy of his death, preceding by only a few months a similar end for a man of like philosophy and dedication, should be cause for each of us to be deeply saddened by our nation's loss and shocked by the climate of violence which breeds such wanton acts;

BE IT RESOLVED that we pause today to dedicate ourselves anew to a course of action in keeping with the dream of Martin Luther King, Jr. for a better world for all men.
