AN ACT

Relating to the licensing of electrical contractors; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 08.40 is amended by adding new sections to read:

Sec. 08.40.175. CEASE AND DESIST ORDER. (a) If the commissioner of labor determines that a person is acting as an electrical contractor in violation of this chapter, he may issue a cease and desist order prohibiting further action by the person as an electrical contractor. The cease and desist order remains in effect until the person has submitted evidence acceptable to the commissioner of labor showing that the violation has been corrected.

(b) A person affected by an order issued under (a) of this section may seek equitable relief preventing the commissioner of labor from enforcing the order.

Sec. 08.40.178. INJUNCTIVE RELIEF. The commissioner of labor may seek an injunction in the superior court to enjoin a person from violating this chapter.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
