AN ACT

Relating to workmen's compensation benefits; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 23.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

ARTICLE 5. COMPUTATION OF COMPENSATION.

Sec. 23.30.172. BENEFIT ADJUSTMENTS. Benefits for temporary and permanent disability shall be calculated under this chapter according to currently existing benefit rates regardless of the benefit rates in existence at the time of the injury, unless this calculation would cause a decrease in the actual benefits receivable.

* Sec. 2. The provisions of this Act apply to persons receiving benefits under AS 23.30 before the effective date of this Act. Funds needed to carry out the provisions of this section shall be appropriated from the general fund.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
