AN ACT

Relating to the legislature.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 24.05.080 is amended to read:

Sec. 24.05.080. TERMS. The term of each member of the legislature begins on the second Monday in January following a presidential election year; however, following a gubernatorial election year, the term of each member begins on the third Monday in January. The term of representatives is two years, and the term of senators is four years. One-half of the senators shall be elected every two years.

* Sec. 2. AS 24.05.090 is amended to read:

Sec. 24.05.090. REGULAR SESSIONS. The legislature shall convene at the capital each year on the second Monday in January at 10:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time; however, following a gubernatorial election year the legislature shall convene on the third Monday in January at 10:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time. Except as provided in this section, each legislature shall have a duration of two years and shall consist of a "First Regular Session" which shall meet in the odd-numbered years and a "Second Regular Session" which shall meet in the even-numbered years and any special session or sessions which the governor or legislature may find necessary to call.
