AN ACT

Relating to family assistance and old age assistance.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 47.25.320(a)(2)(A) is amended to read:

(A) for a parent and one child under 18, a maximum of \$300;

* Sec. 2. AS 47.25.320(a)(2)(B) is repealed.

* Sec. 3. AS 47.25.435 is amended to read:

Sec. 47.25.435. EXCLUSION OF INCOME. Notwithstanding the provisions of secs. 430 - 610 of this chapter, if the applicable provisions of the federal Social Security Act, as amended, permit, in determining the need of an applicant for, or a recipient of, an old age assistance grant under secs. 430 - 610 of this chapter, the department shall exclude from the computation of the applicant's or recipient's income a sum not to exceed \$65 a month plus one-half of the balance of the income that is earned in any manner, until financial ineligibility is reached. The department may promulgate regulations it considers appropriate to carry out the provisions of this section.
