AN ACT

Relating to the making of false reports to a peace officer.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 11.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 11.30.215. MAKING A FALSE REPORT TO A PEACE OFFICER. (a) A person who wilfully and knowingly makes, or causes another to make, a false report of an alleged criminal offense to a peace officer or a law enforcement agency is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not more than one year, or by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by both.

(b) In addition to the penalties prescribed in (a) of this section, the court may require restitution by the convicted person to the law enforcement agency involved for all expenses incurred as a direct result of the false report.
