AN ACT

Relating to buying, receiving, or concealing stolen property.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 11.20.230(a) is amended to read:

(a) A person who buys, receives, or conceals money, goods, bank notes, or other thing which may be the subject of larceny and which has been taken, embezzled, or stolen from another person, knowing it to have been taken, embezzled, or stolen, is upon conviction punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 and by imprisonment for not less than one year nor more than three years if the property bought, received, or concealed exceeds \$250 in value; if the property bought, received, or concealed does not exceed \$250 in value, by imprisonment for not less than one month nor more than one year or by a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$250.
