5 * Section 1. AS 05.15.060 is amended to read:

6 Sec. 05.15.060. REGULATIONS. The department shall adopt regulations under the
7 Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62) necessary to carry out this chapter covering, but not
8 limited to,

9 (1) the issuance, renewal, and revocation of permits and licenses;

10 (2) a method of ascertaining net proceeds, the determination of items of expense
11 that may be incurred or paid, and the limitation of the amount of the items of expense to prevent
12 the proceeds from the activity permitted from being diverted to noncharitable, noneducational,
13 nonreligious, or profit-making organizations, individuals, or groups;

14 (3) the immediate revocation of permits and licenses authorized under this chapter
15 if this chapter or regulations adopted under it are violated;

16 (4) the requiring of detailed, sworn, financial reports of operations from permittees
17 and licensees including detailed statements of receipts and payments;

18 (5) the investigation of permittees, licensees, and their employees, including the
19 fingerprinting of those permittees, licensees, and employees whom the commissioner considers
20 it advisable to fingerprint;

21 (6) exclusion from participation as a permittee, licensee, or employee of a

1 permittee or licensee, of a person convicted of, in prison for, or on parole for a felony within the
2 preceding five years, or convicted of a crime involving theft or dishonesty or of a violation of
3 a municipal, state, or federal gambling law;

4 (7) the method and manner of conducting authorized activities and awarding of
5 prizes or awards, and the equipment that may be used;

6 (8) the number of activities that may be held, operated, or conducted under a
7 permit during a specified period; however, the department may not allow more than 14 bingo
8 sessions a month and 35 bingo games a session to be conducted under a permit;

9 (9) a method of accounting for receipts and disbursements by operators, including
10 the keeping of records and requirements for the deposit of all receipts in a bank;

11 (10) the disposition of funds in possession of a permittee or a person,
12 municipality, or qualified organization that possesses an operator's license at the time a permit
13 or a license is surrendered, revoked, or invalidated;

14 (11) restrictions on the participation by employees of the Department of Fish and
15 Game in salmon classics and in king salmon classics, and by employees of Douglas Island
16 Pink and Chum in king salmon classics;

17 (12) other matters the commissioner considers necessary to carry out this chapter
18 or protect the best interest of the public.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 05.15.100(a) is amended to read:

20 (a) The commissioner may issue a permit to a municipality or qualified organization.
21 The permit gives the municipality or qualified organization the privilege of conducting bingo,
22 raffles and lotteries, pull-tab games, ice classics, rain classics, goose classics, mercury classics,
23 salmon classics, king salmon classics, dog mushers' contests, fish derbies, and contests of skill.

24 * Sec. 3. AS 05.15.115(c) is amended to read:

25 (c) A permittee may not contract with more than one operator at a time to conduct the
26 same type of activity. For the purposes of this subsection, bingo games, raffles, lotteries, pull-tab
27 games, ice classics, rain classics, goose classics, mercury classics, salmon classics, king salmon
28 classics, dog mushers' contests, fish derbies, contests of skill, and all activities permitted under
29 AS 05.15.100(b) are each a different type of activity.

30 * Sec. 4. AS 05.15.180(b) is amended to read:

1 (b) With the exception of raffles, lotteries, bingo games, pull-tab games, rain classics,
2 goose classics, mercury classics, salmon classics, king salmon classics, and other activities
3 authorized under AS 05.15.100(b), an activity may not be licensed under this chapter unless it
4 existed in the state in substantially the same form and was conducted in substantially the same
5 manner before January 1, 1959.

6 * Sec. 5. AS 05.15.210 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

7 (35) "king salmon classic" means a game of chance where a prize of money is
8 awarded for the closest guess of the time of the arrival of the first king salmon of the year at a
9 designated spot on the fish ladder in the Douglas Island Pink and Chum hatchery at Salmon
10 Creek in Juneau and is limited to the king salmon classic operated and administered by the
11 Greater Juneau Chamber of Commerce.

12 * Sec. 6. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
