1 Relating to the definition of the crime of harassment; and providing for an effective date.

3 * **Section 1.** AS 11.61.120(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) A person commits the crime of harassment if, with intent to harass or
5 annoy another person, that person

6 (1) insults, taunts, or challenges another person in a manner likely to
7 provoke an immediate violent response;

8 (2) telephones another and fails to terminate the connection with intent
9 to impair the ability of that person to place or receive telephone calls;

10 (3) makes repeated telephone calls at extremely inconvenient hours;

11 (4) makes an anonymous or obscene telephone call, an obscene
12 electronic communication, or a telephone call or electronic communication that
13 threatens physical injury or sexual contact; [OR]

1 (5) subjects another person to offensive physical contact; or
2 (6) publishes or distributes electronic or printed photographs,
3 pictures, or films that show the genitals, anus, or female breast of the other
4 person or show that person engaged in a sexual act.

5 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
