AN ACT

Relating to collecting information about civil litigation by the Alaska Judicial Council; repealing Rule 41(a)(3), Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure, and Rules 511(c) and (e), Alaska Rules of Appellate Procedure; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

1 Relating to collecting information about civil litigation by the Alaska Judicial Council;
2 repealing Rule 41(a)(3), Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure, and Rules 511(c) and (e), Alaska
3 Rules of Appellate Procedure; and providing for an effective date.

5 * **Section 1.** Rule 41(a)(3), Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure, and Rules 511(c) and (e),
6 Alaska Rules of Appellate Procedure, are repealed.

7 * **Sec. 2.** AS 09.68.130 is repealed.

8 * **Sec. 3.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
9 read:

10 CONDITIONAL EFFECT. This Act takes effect only if sec. 1 of this Act receives the
11 two-thirds majority vote of each house required by art. IV, sec. 15, Constitution of the State of
12 Alaska.

13 * **Sec. 4.** If this Act takes effect under sec. 3 of this Act, it takes effect immediately under
14 AS 01.10.070(c).
