JOINT SESSION

Speaker Malone call the House to order and deferred to President Rader who called the joint session to order at 10:10 a.m.

Senator Colletta moved and asked unanimous consent that the roll call of the Senate be waived and all members be shown as present. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

Mr. Miller moved and asked unanimous consent that the roll call of the House be waived and all members be shown as present. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

The prayer was offered by the Chaplain, Pastor Brice Quinn of the Church of God.

President Rader appointed Senator Bradley and Representative Bradley to escort Senator Gravel to and from the joint session.

President Rader introduced Senator Gravel.

Senator Gravel addressed the joint session on his assessment of the future of Alaska land legislation in Congress. A question and answer period followed.

Senator Gravel received a standing ovation at the conclusion of his remarks.

Senator Colletta stated that the Senate will reconvene at 1:30 p.m.

Senator Colletta moved and asked unanimous consent that the joint session adjourn. There being no objection, the joint session adjourned at 11:32 a.m.
