JOINT SESSION IN THE HOUSE

The Speaker of the House called the joint session to order at 11:15 a.m. and deferred to the President of the Senate.

Mr. Miller moved and asked unanimous consent that the roll call of the House be waived and all members be shown as present. Without objection, it was so ordered.

The President appointed Senator Ziegler and Representative Rhode to escort Chief Justice Boochever of the Alaska Supreme Court to and from the joint session.

The Honorable Chief Justice Boochever was escorted to the rostrum and was introduced by President Croft.

Chief Justice Boochever addressed the joint session on the subject of the judicial system in Alaska, and introduced the following members of the Supreme Court to the members of the Legislature:
