

AFTER RECESSJOINT SESSION IN THE HOUSE

Speaker Grussendorf called the House to order and, in accordance with the Uniform Rules, turned the gavel over to President Eliason who called the joint session to order at 11:12 a.m.

The purpose of the joint session was to hear the State of the Judiciary address by the Honorable Jay A. Rabinowitz, Chief Justice of the Alaska Supreme Court.

Senator Halford moved and asked unanimous consent that the roll call of the Senate be waived and all members be shown as present. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

Representative Gruenberg moved and asked unanimous consent that the roll call of the House be waived and all members be shown as present. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

President Eliason appointed Representative Donley and Senator Rodey to escort the Chief Justice to the joint session.

Chief Justice Rabinowitz was escorted to the rostrum and welcomed by President Eliason.

Accompanying the Chief Justice were Justices Edmond Burke, Daniel Moore, Allen Compton and Warren W. Matthews, who were introduced by Chief Justice Rabinowitz.

Chief Justice Rabinowitz delivered his State of the Judiciary address. (A prepared text was not submitted for publication.)

Chief Justice Rabinowitz received a standing ovation and was escorted from the Chamber by Representative Donley and Senator Rodey.

Senator Halford moved and asked unanimous consent that the joint session adjourn. There being no objection, President Eliason adjourned the joint session at 11:39 a.m.

The Speaker ordered the House at ease to allow members of the Senate to leave the Chamber.

The Speaker called the House back to order at 11:45 a.m.
