February 1, 1957

Pursuant to adjournment, the House was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Speaker Greuel.

Roll call showed all members present.

Prayer was offered by the Chaplain.

At the request of Mr. Norene, Chairman of the Engrossment and Enrollment Committee, and with unanimous consent, the Journal for the Fourth Day was approved as read.

Thereupon the House recessed.

AFTER RECESS

The House was called to order at 10:25 a.m. by the Speaker in preparation of the Joint Session.

JOINT SESSION

The President of the Senate called the Joint Session to order at 10:30 a.m.

The Secretary of the Senate called the roll of the Senate. All members were present.

The Chief Clerk of the House called the roll of the House. All members were present.

The President of the Senate announced that Representative Coghill had been appointed to escort the Acting Governor to the Chair.

Senator Cooper moved and asked unanimous consent that the Joint Rules of the Senate and House as introduced by the Twenty-Second Session of the Alaska Legislature be adopted temporarily as the Rules for the Twenty-Third Session of the Alaska Legislature. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

Representative Coghill escorted the Acting Governor to the Chair.

The President of the Senate acknowledged the Acting Governor's arrival to the Joint Session. The Speaker of the House introduced His Excellency, the Acting Governor of Alaska Waino E. Hendrickson.

Thereupon the Acting Governor delivered his message.

A rising vote of thanks was then given Acting Governor Hendrickson by the Joint Session of the House and Senate for his message.
