## XIII.

## (JOINT) RESOLUTIONS AND MEMORIALS.

## Rule 60.—

All memorials and all joint or concurrent resolutions shall be acted upon the same as bills, unless otherwise ordered by the majority of the House.

## XIV.

## Rule 61.—Committee Sittings.

No committee shall sit during the sittings of the House without special leave; and its writs, warrants, and subpoenas issued by order of the House, shall be under the hand and seal of the Speaker, attested by the clerk.

## Rule 62.—Committee on Committees.

The House shall elect a committee on committees to be composed of the Speaker and one member of each division, and the said committee on committees to nominate for election by the House all standing committees.

## Rule 63.—Standing Committees.

There shall be fifteen standing committees to consist of the following:

- 1.—Committee on Committees, to consist of five members including the Speaker.
- 2.—Banks, Banking and Corporations, including Municipal to consist of seven members.
- 3.—Transportation, Commerce and Navigation, to consist of five members.
- 4.—Ways and Means and Contingent Expenses, to consist of seven members.
- 5.—Elections, Election Laws and Mileage, to consist of five members.
- 6.—Engrossment and Enrollment, to consist of three members.
- 7.—Fisheries, Fish, Game and Agriculture, to consist of five members.
- 8.—Education, Public Health, Quarantine and Modrals, to consist of three members.
- 9.—Judiciary and Federal Relations, to consist of five members.
- 10.—Labor, Capital and Immigration, to consist of five members.
- 11.—Territorial Institutions, to consist of three members.
- 12.—Printing, to consist of three members.
- 13.—Roads and Highways, to consist of five members.
- 14.—Mining and Manufactures, to consist of five members.
- 15.—Rules, to consist of four members.
